

## 4 Conversations to Have with Your Kids About Julie's Greenroom

> Families can talk about what goes into creating a stage production. Kids: What different roles must be filled onstage and behind the scenes to make a successful show? If one or two jobs go undone, how does it affect the whole project? What other undertakings can you think of that would suffer similar fate without a full group effort?

> In what ways are the Greenies reflective of our diverse society? Why is it good to surround yourself with people whose experiences are different from yours? On the other hand, what challenges does diversity present? How do we work through them?

> Kids: What does this show have to say about perseverance? What examples of adversity do the characters experience on their journey toward their performance? What role does teamwork play in their ability to do so? Can you think of any other character strengths that are important for a creative person?

> Families can use this series to inspire cultural field trips of their own. Attend a play, an art show, a dance performance, or a concert together. Talk about how the art form affected you. Is there one in particular that interests your kids? How does art allow you to express yourself in unique ways?
